

## Recent Updates

1. It is now mandatory to register a Hindi domain under सरकार.भारत along with English Domain Name. Kindly note that the domain allocation is to be made in compliance with the guidelines released by MeitY [https://registry.gov.in/pdfdocs/Gov.In\\_Guidelines.pdf](https://registry.gov.in/pdfdocs/Gov.In_Guidelines.pdf)

2. The Hindi domain or the domain in any other language (called IDN Domain which stands for Internationalised Domain Name) can be taken without any registration request letter. All the contact details and all other related information of the corresponding English domain will be attached to the IDN domain and maintained together. No separate details would be maintained for IDN Domain. However, registration guidelines compliance is mandatory for IDN registration too.

3. Domain renewal process has been replaced with contact update (organization, administrative) in the interval of every six months.

4. No original copy (physical) is required to send for any of the service taken through registry.gov.in. Only Clean scan copy of the document needs to be uploaded online at <https://registry.gov.in> for requesting the service.

5. Subdomain Activities

- a. No separate permission is required for enabling sub-domain registration services at <https://registry.gov.in> for those 3rd level active domains which are hosted in NIC cloud.

- b. The concerned service provided needs to be contacted for subdomain services in case the domain is not hosted in NIC cloud.

6. In case of transferring a domain name from one login account to another login account, the domain transfer request letter should be signed by his/her reporting officer of the domain owning organization. In such a scenario the domain account transfer letter must not be self-signed.

In case a Nodal Officer is not nominated by any Ministry/Department/State/Organization the application (registration letter) must be written and signed by an officer (as per the listed designations of Central and State level non-nodal officer, to be attached below for taking approval) and forwarded by the concerned NIC HOG/SIO.
